Fashion Terms

Fashion is fun, colourful and glamorous. These list of terms and their explanations are fashion related words that differentiate the fashion talk of the common man from the fashion designers and editors who decide the course of fashion.

Dress

Garments used for a particular event worn by both men and women.

Apparel

Style

A particular design, shape or type of apparel item that makes it easy to recognize. Distinct features on a garment determines the style. Can you see the styles in the image below?



Vogue

The current fashion trend. When something is said to be in vogue, it means it is currently in trend or in style. If you keep up with fashion trends, you are likely to know what's in vogue for a particular season.



Figure flattery/illusion

Dressing in clothes that enhances areas of your body you want to show off, while at the same time downplaying those parts you are most conscious of.

Ensemble

A French word, ensemble is usually referred to an outfit complete with accessories, jewellery and anything else that adds to the completeness of the outfit.

Silhouette

Costume

A distinctive style of dress of an individual or group that reflects their class, gender, profession, ethnicity or activity.



Mass Market

This term refers to goods that are produced in large quantities or mass produced. Simple production techniques are used, therefore to sell at cheaper rates.

Brand name

Brand name is one which is used to easily identify and distinguish one product from another.



Catwalk

An area, walkway or platform, which models use to parade clothes in fashion shows.



Fashion

A style of clothing that is popular at a given time.

Fashion trend

Direction in which styles, colours, fabrics and designs are tending to change. This is often influenced by political events, films, personalities, social and sporting events.



This image dated October 3rd 1818 displays the latest style trends at that time. Fashion trends have surely changed a lot.

Fashion show

This is an occasion used by fashion designers display their new line of clothing and accessories.



Fashion Week

A week-long event, where fashion designers display their latest collections via fashion shows to buyers and the media. This event influences trends for the current and upcoming season.

Design To make drawings or preliminary sketches for garments.

Designer

A person who designs high-fashion clothing. The designer has the responsibility to create the particular look of the garments. This includes all the features of the garment such as, type of fabric, colour of fabric, shape of the garment, trimmings and notions.

Types of Fashion

Fad

A fashion that becomes popular and after a while loses popularity.

Couture (koo-ture)

French term for business, in which original apparel designs are created by designers. A client's specific requirements and measurements are used in creating these designs.

Haute couture (oat koo-toor)

This term is French and speaks to exclusive designer creations utilizing sewing or dressmaking skills that are of a very high standard. The construction of haute couture outfits are done totally by hand and this accounts for its exclusiveness. They are custom-made according to the wearer's size and is always a limited edition and more expensive than ready-to-wear garments.



Classic Clothing that continues to be popular and acceptable through time. They can be worn year after year and still remain popular due to their simple style lines and general appeal. Most classic clothing are neutral colours.

Avant Garde (ah-vant gard)

French term meaning new, unconventional, ahead of its time. Used to describe apparel that may be provocative or startling.
