## TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

## **TOPIC: THE FAMILY**

- 1. **Alimony** husband/or wife's provision for a spouse after a separation or divorce; also known as maintenance.
- 2. **Annulment** the legal ending of a marriage/marriage is null and void
- 3. **Bigamy** situation where someone who has a husband or wife living, and marries someone else
- 4. **Blended family** a family unit made up of two adults and their children from previous relationships
- 5. **Divorce** the process of legally ending a marriage
- 6. **Extended family** in addition to a nuclear family includes additional generations and relations who live together in the same household; for example: aunts, uncles, grandparents
- 7. **Family** a group of people related by blood, marriage or adoption and who share a common household/residence
- 8. **Incest** sexual relations between close members of a family
- 9. **Inheritance** the passing of assets or goods from someone who has died to others
- 10. **Kinship** the relationship between members of the same family
- 11. Legal separation -separation of a married couple by court order
- 12. Matrilineal Tracing descent through mother's lines
- 13. **Matrifocal** a family headed by a mother, mother is the focal point
- 14. **Matriarchal** where the mother /grandmother normally heads the household or is the authority
- 15. Marriage a formal legal relationship between a couple
- 16. **Monogamy** a situation where one woman is married to one man
- 17. **Nuclear family** a family including both parents and their child/children
- 18. **Patriarchal** where the father/grandfather normally heads the household or is the authority
- 19. **Patrifocal** type of family centred on the father, the father is the focus
- 20. **Patrilineal** tracing descent through male's lines
- 21. **Polygamy** the practice of having more than one husband or wife at the same time
- 22. **Polyandry** having more than one husband at the same time
- 23. **Polygyny** having more than one wife at the same time
- 24. **Sibling** brother or sister
- 25. **Single parent family** a family unit including one parent and his /her child/ children
- 26. **Status** how highly a person is regarded in the social group
