Topic	<b>The Indigenous People and the Europeans-The impact of European presence in Tobago</b>
Outcome	Analyse the impact of the early Europeans present in Tobago's development. Use primary and secondary sources to research the social, economic and political development of Tobago.
Teaching Points	Tobago changed hands many times during the course of her historical development. Tobago similar to other Caribbean territories, for example St. Lucia was used as a pawn in the wars that were fought in the 17 <sup>th</sup> and 18 <sup>th</sup> centuries between the different European powers.
