FOCUS: MAKING DOLL AND PROPS for Stay at Home scenario

Content	Activities	Possible Tools and materials needed
<i>Demonstrate ways to solve problems through the use of the elements and principles of design.</i>	<p>Make a human-like model / doll from either paper mash or paper clay</p> <p>Create an appropriate costume on your paper model / doll</p> <p>Make two (2) props using various materials available at home</p> <p>Create a scenario with your props and paper doll to demonstrate one (1) safety measure citizens of Trinidad and Tobago are using during the Stay at Home period.</p>	<p>-Recycled paper- old newspapers, brown paper etc</p> <p>-White glue</p> <p>-Pieces of fabric</p> <p>-Glue to stick fabric</p> <p>-Paint</p> <p>-Cardboard, plastic bottles etc.</p>

Activities:

- **Model / Doll making**

Use either **paper mash or paper clay** and make a human-like model / doll (12 cm in height will do).

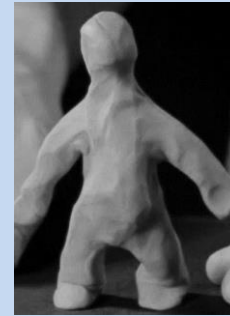

Paper mash instructions: soak shredded paper in warm water for 2 hours. Place soaked recycled paper into a blender with water. Strain the pulp using a colander or sieve. Mix the pulp with one tablespoon or more of white glue.



An adult will have to assist you in getting the warm water. This is for YOUR safety.

Your model / doll should look like this



You can add eyes and mouth etc...Have fun!

Let it dry.

You can paint your model for realistic colouring!

Use your skin colour as a guide!

- **Scene making-**

At this point, you should decide on your **scenario**. Brainstorm different ideas by researching safety measures asked of citizens during this Stay at Home Order. Write each idea and then choose the best one. Good job!

- **Prop making-**

Do you know what is a prop in a scenario?

A prop in a scenario is any object which can move that adds value to the scene.

In the scene below, the arrows are pointing to some props.



Can you find 3 more props in this picture?
Place an **X** by 2 other props.

You have already decided on your scenario, **now make 2 props** which will add value to your scenario.
Remember, you are making small props for your scenario to match the size of your model / doll.

- **Costume making-**

Decide on the BEST colours to make your costume for your scenario.

Collect small pieces of fabric to make your costume. Cut your fabric to make your costume and stick onto your model / doll.

Please be careful with the scissors. Let an adult assist you with cutting the fabric.



- Assemble your props with your costumed paper model and create your Stay at Home safety measure scenario.
- Take a pic for your art journal and your art portfolio.
- **Present your scenario to your family.**
