#### **ANTS**

Ants are insects that are social in habit and live together in organized colonies. Ants are found worldwide, but are more common in hot climates. They range in size from about two to twenty-five millimetres. Their colour is usually yellow, brown, red, or black. Most ants live in nests, which may be located in the ground, or under a rock. Some nests are built above ground and made of twigs, sand, or gravel.

<u>Carpenter ants</u> are large black ants that live in old logs and timbers. Some species live in trees or in the hollow stems of weeds. Tailor ants make nests of leaves and similar materials held together with silk secreted by larvae. The pharaoh ant, a small yellowish <u>insect</u>, builds its nest either in houses or outdoors. It all depends on if it is warm or cold.
