PHONICS- HARD AND SOFT 'C' AND 'G'

Curriculum Topic: Phonics – Hard and soft 'c' and 'g'-Standard Four

Teaching Point:

HARD AND SOFT C and G

- The letters **c** and **g** followed by **e, i** or **y** usually stand for their soft sounds as in **cent** and **page**. The letters **c** and **g** followed by any other letters or at the end of words stand for their hard sounds, as in **cat**, **attic**, **gone** and **bag**.

Activity

In the following image, the names of the pictures contain a hard or soft 'c' or 'g'.

1. Locate the 5 soft 'c' and 5 soft 'g' pictures.

E.g.  Dog has a hard 'g' sound

2. Write the words in the table provided
3. Choose any 5 words from your list and write 5 sentences
