The importance of finding relevant and adequate sources

After identifying and accessing sources, the next step is to decipher the relevancy of the sources and how adequate these sources are. Adequacy does not mean that the research must have an over indulgence of sources, but it must have a sufficient amount of credible sources based on the scope and nature of the research. For the purposes of the CAPE level between six to eight sources. For relevancy the sources must be connected or relatable. An overwhelming preponderance of sources from first world countries , if one is looking at an issue in a developing country like Barbados or Jamaica may be problematic

Pertinence to the matter at hand.
Relevance is a term used to describe how pertinent, connected, or applicable some information is to a given manner.
