

Writing Bibliographies and References

Introduction:

Giving credit for work that is not yours is very important. Bibliography and reference (citation) helps to prevent plagiarism is intellectual theft, the claim that someone else's ideas and words are yours. It allows acknowledgement to be given for the contribution of other researchers in your research. Some of the benefits of referencing include:

- it shows that actual research has been done
- it allows readers to verify the information
- it strengthens arguments proposed
